Double Bundeschampion 2007/2009

Denario is a beautiful stallion with outstanding movement, with rarely seen looseness; he is always well balanced, has a very good free jump and an excellent trainable temperament that is passed onto his foals.

Denario's unique career began at the South Stallion days in Munich in 2006 where he was appointed champion stallion. He achieved 3rd place at the heavily manned 30-day test (8.5).

In 2007, Denario won 3 championships. He won the Bavarian Championships in Ansbach, the Southern Championship in Nordlingen (with a foreign riders dream score of 9.75) and as a culmination victory at the German Bundeschampionships.

In 2008 he won the Southern Dressage Championships, and finished in 8th place in the finals of the 5-year olds.

In 2009 he again was proclaimed Bundeschampion, this time for 6 year old riding horses.

Denario descends from the Birkhof-sire Denaro (Dressage index of 146) of Donnerhall descent, who was a finalist at the National Young Horse Championships and who produced excellent foals. Denario's dam descends from the Reserve Champion of the '89 approvals in Oldenburg, Fair Play, who himself was highly successful up to advanced dressage level. His pedigree is rounded off by established Hanoverian bloodlines such as Wiener Dom (Wienerwald/ Domspatz) and by adding two renowned thoroughbreds: Vollkorn xx and Der Löwe xx.
