Movement doesn't start with a "W" just in the Hanoverian breeding area! Like no other stallion line, the line of the Celle sire, Woermann, stands for strong-moving dressage horses such as the current German Vice Champion, Warum nicht FRH, ridden by Isabell Werth.

This outstanding stallion line is represented in Klein Roscharden by World of Dreams: This strong typed, dark chestnut out of a dam by the Thoroughbred sire, Cardinal, was trained in the US all the way up to Grand Prix by Michelle Gibson, who took fourth place at the Olympic Games in Athens. After returning to Germany he has been successful in advanced level tests with Britta Klatte.

Sesam, found in the third generation, deserves attention as a representative of the Semper line which was in full blossom during the 70s. World of Dream's first foals which were born in 2006 showed outstanding movement qualities which judges honored by awarding high scores at foal shows. One of his foals qualified for the German Foal Championship final in Lienen.
